

## Key Stage 4

Subject: Cambridge National Child Development

### Intent

To promote an enjoyment of the subject by preparing students with knowledge and practical skills in preparation for further qualifications, associated careers and life in the future.

All students will learn the essential knowledge and understanding for child development covering reproduction, parental responsibility, antenatal care, birth, post-natal checks, conditions required for development, childhood illnesses and child safety. Students will gain knowledge of the equipment needs of babies and young children and an understanding of the factors to be considered when choosing appropriate equipment to meet all these needs. They will also gain knowledge of nutrition and hygiene practices and will be given the opportunity to evaluate dietary choices. Students will gain knowledge of, and skills in, developing activities to observe development norms in children up to the age of five. Students will research, plan and carry out activities with children and make observations of their development.
