Intent

“We aim to inspire a curiosity and fascination about the world and its people. Students will develop knowledge about diverse places, people, resources and natural and human environments, together with a deep understanding of the Earth’s key physical and human processes. Students will learn how landscapes and environments have formed over time including how people use these today. Students will develop a greater understanding of how local actions can have wide ranging implications on a global scale; furthermore, developing an awareness of controversial issues, encouraging them to develop informed opinions relating to them. In addition, studying geography will develop an understanding of different cultures and communities in Britain and elsewhere”
