Year 10	1. Encourage your child to actively engage in the subject; support this by talking to your child about their learning in the subject. 2. Encourage your child to respond to teacher feedback, making improvements to their work and catch up on any work missed. 3. Encourage your child to attend support and/or intervention sessions whilst completing internally assessed assignments. 4. Encourage your child to manage their time effectively through spending time completing internally assessed assignments at home and meeting the set deadline/s.
